

# Elections for municipal councillors and for mayors on 27 October 2019

Dear citizens of the European Union member states, you have the right to vote in the elections for municipal councillors and for mayors on 27 October if you have attained the age of 18 as at the election day, have the status of long-term or permanent resident in the Republic of Bulgaria, have permanent and present address registration on the territory of the country as at 26 April 2019 and at least one of your addresses is in the municipality or mayors' district where you will vote, you are not deprived of the right to vote in the country, of which you are a national, you are not under judicial disability and you are not deprived of liberty.

## What should you do on the election day?

You can vote for a municipality mayor, district mayor, mayor of a mayor's district and for the list of candidates for municipal councillors if you are registered in the electoral roll.



On the board in front of the voting room you can acquaint with the names of the candidates for mayors and with the municipal councillor lists. In the voting room you must pass your identity document – an ID card or a passport and certificate of residence to a commission member in order to verify the data in the list.

A commission member shall tear off from the stub a single voting-paper for each choice you may make, affixed a stamp on the backside thereof and hand it over to you.

## Voting

When you are in the voting booth, write “X” or “V” with a blue-ink pen in only one of the boxes for voting with a voting-paper for a mayor. In the voting-paper for municipal councillors, please mark the list of the party, coalition or independent candidate chosen by you. If you prefer any of the candidates of the party or coalition chosen by you, please indicate a preference in the circle with such candidate's three-digit number.



In case you do not want to support a candidate of a party, coalition or an independent candidate, you may indicate “I do not support anyone”.

Fold the voting-papers so that your vote is not visible.

Leave the booth, hand over the voting-paper to a member of the Section Voting Commission so that he/she affixes a second stamp on the backside thereof and tear the pieces. Drop the voting-paper in the transparent box.

Sign in the list. Take back your personal documents.

When none of the candidates is elected, a second round of the elections will take place on 03 November 2019.

The vote shall start at 7.00 and end at 20.00.
